### **Muscle Hill's clean sweep**

**MUSCLE HILL** was the leading sire of trotters in North America for 2020 in every category – all aged, two-year-old and three-year-old.

During the year **MUSCLE HILL** left the winners of \$9,731,010, of which his two and three-year-olds earned \$7,348,992.

**TRIXTON**, who finished in fourth position on the three-year-old list and tenth overall, sired the winners of \$3,503,096 and **ROYALTY FOR LIFE's** progeny earned \$2,020,280.

**SOUTHWIND FRANK** was the second leading first-season sire with \$1,183,436 from only 49 foals

Two of **MUSCLE HILL's** stock won Dan Patch Awards for the leading horses in their divisions in 2020.

**Ramona Hill**, the winner of the \$1 million Hambletonian and \$915,615 in stakes, was named USA 3YO Trotting Filly of the Year, while **Manchego**, the Breeders Crown champion and TVG Series winner, was adjudged as USA Older Female Trotter of the Year.

### **Lane Of Stone tops \$500,000 mark**

**Lane Of Stone**, a five-year-old entire son of **WISHING STONE**, sent his stake earnings over the \$500,000 plateau with a convincing 1:54 triumph in Miami Valley Raceway's \$US22,000 Open Trot on Tuesday (January 19).

Sent to the front at the end of the 28.2 opening quarter, **Lane Of Stone** carved fractions of 29, 28.2 and 28.6 to gain the thick end of the prize.

It was his 21st lifetime success. As a three-year-old he captured the Ohio Sires Stakes Championship and the Scarlet And Gray Invitation.

**Lane Of Stone** is out of the Lindy Lane mare Wisteria Lane (1:57.6).
