New winner by Trixton

Justatrixta, a three-year-old filly and one of the first crop of the Hambletonian winner **TRIXTON**, won her first race at only her third start at Bendigo on Friday night (January 3).

The filly raced wide throughout, running her last 800 in a slick 58.6.

She is out of the Sundon mare Justa Phoenix, who has left three winners from her first three foals.

TRIXTON has sired three winners and a placegetter from four starters from a first crop of only 10 foals in Australia.

Muscle Hill progeny dominate Dan Patch Awards
Real Cool Sam, Ramona Hill and **When Dovescry**, a trio of **MUSCLE HILL** sired brilliant, young trotters, were named as Dan Patch Award winners as the leaders in their divisions for 2019.

Real Cool Sam, a two-year-old gelding out of a Broadway Hall mare, won his first nine starts and set five divisional world records along the way. He earned \$497,774 and took a mark of 1:52.2 at Lexington, making him the fastest freshman trotting gelding of all-time.

Among his major successes were the \$324,550 Peter Haughton Memorial and the \$252,000 Pennsylvania Sire Stakes Championship.

Ramona Hill, a two-year-old filly out of a **LUCKY CHUCKY** mare, won six of her seven starts, earned \$405,400 and took a record of 1:52.4. Her standout performance for the year was winning the \$600,000 Breeders Crown by four lengths at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

When Dovescry, a three-year-old filly from a Andover Hall mare, won five of her 12 starts including the \$500,000 Hambletonian Oaks and the \$176,150 Matron Stakes. She banked \$644,380 and took her record of 1:50.2 at Lexington and was the richest and equal fastest of her age, sex and gait for the year.

Cup winner by Muscle Hill

The brilliant win of **Dance Craze** in the Group 2 \$30,000 E. B. Cochran Cup at Ballarat was the highlight of a host of winners by **MUSCLE HILL** in the holiday racing.

Dance Craze, who survived a torrid passage, sent her stake earnings over the \$400,000 mark. IT was her eighth win at Group level.

MUSCLE HILL has also left the Bendigo winner **Bullion Lady** and the NZ 3YO winners **Bolt For Brilliance** (Auckland), **Midnight Dash** (Nelson) and **Kahress** (Blenheim).

TRIXTON was represented by a 'new' winner in the 3YO filly **Gaytana**, who notched her first win at Nelson, NZ, and the Bendigo 3YO winner **Justatrixta**.

TRIXTON has sired four winners to date from only 20 Australasian bred foals.
