Kindergarten Classic double

The \$366,000 Kindergarten Classic Series for two-year-old trotters, held at Vernon Downs, New York last Saturday night (October 31), proved a triumph for Stallions Australasia sires **LUCKY CHUCKY** and **MUSCLE HILL**.

Dog Gone Lucky, a **LUCKY CHUCKY** colt, took out the \$191,500 race for colts and geldings, overcoming the No 9 post and winning by two lengths in a career-best 1:54.4.

Out of a mare by **Cash Hall**, **Dog Gone Lucky** has earned \$213,343 from four wins in 11 starts.

LUCKY CHUCKY'S stock has won on the Grand Circuit as two and three-year-olds.

In the \$174,500 Kindergarten for two-year-old fillies the **MUSCLE HILL** entry **Wildflower**, a 90 to 1 outsider, finished resolutely to score in a new mark of 1:55.8.

From a **Yankee Glide** mare, **Wildflower** has banked \$120,826 from only seven starts.

MUSCLE HILL is the leading sire of two-year-old trotters in North America this year with progeny earnings of \$2.6-million. **LUCKY CHUCKY'S** stock has earned \$760,000 as two-year-olds and \$930,000 as three-year-olds in 2015.

World record for Mission Brief

MUSCLE HILL'S champion 3YO filly **Mission Brief** hoisted a fresh world record for her age, gait and sex when she annexed the \$187,400 Matron Stake in 1:50.4 at Dover Downs, Delaware on November 12.

Sent to the front after the opening quarter, the filly proceeded to blitz her rivals, scoring untested by 5-3/4 lengths.

It was **Mission Brief's** ninth win from 13 starts this year and boosted her lifetime stake earnings to a whopping \$1,520,387, of which \$929,317 has been won in 2015.

LUCKY CHUCKY'S brilliant youngster **Dog Gone Lucky** notched his second important Stakes success for the month when he captured the \$216,300 Matron Stake for 2YO colts and geldings in 1:55 at Dover Downs on November 5. Nine days later **Dog Gone Lucky** won a \$20,000 elimination of the Valley Victory at The Meadowlands in 1:55.4, his sixth win from 13 starts for \$331,493 in stakes.

MUSCLE HILL'S 2YO Breeders Crown champion **All The Time** made it seven wins from 11 tries when she scored an authoritative win a \$20,000 elimination of the Goldsmith Maid in 1:56.4 at The Meadowlands. She boasts a bankroll of \$452,240.

Resolve, a 4YO entire, led in a **MUSCLE HILL** quinella in a \$50,000 preliminary of the TVG Free-for-all at The Meadowlands, leading throughout in 1:53.6 to beat **E L Titan**.

MUSCLE HILL is currently second on the 2YO Sires' list, third on the 3YO table and fourth on the All Aged list from just three racing crops, while **LUCKY CHUCKY** is now a Top 10 2YO sire in North America from a crop of 63 foals.

Grand Circuit treble for Stallions Australasia

The Stallions Australasia sires **LUCKY CHUCKY** and **MUSCLE HILL** made a clean sweep of the three Grand Circuit events held at The Meadowlands on Saturday night (November 21).

Dog Gone Lucky, a 2YO colt by former USA 2YO and 3YO Trotter of the Year **LUCKY CHUCKY**, started the ball rolling when he dead-heated in the \$489,400 Valley Victory after leading for the final 1200 metres.

Ripping home in 57 seconds, **Dog Gone Lucky** cut the mile in a career-best 1:54.

Dog Gone Lucky has won five races on end and seven from 14 lifetime starts and his stakes tally of \$505,841, making him the second richest two-year-old male trotter in 2015.

A Top Ten sire, **LUCKY CHUCKY'S** juveniles have amassed \$1,053,323 in stakes this year.

MUSCLE HILL'S world champion filly **Mission Brief** sent her season's earnings over the \$1-million mark when she scored a dominant win in 1:51.6 in the \$144,000 Continental victory for 3YO fillies.

Sent straight to the top, **Mission Brief** carved out fractions of 27.8, 28.2, 28.2 and 27.4 to win untouched by five lengths.

Mission Brief has won 19 of her 27 lifetime starts and almost \$1.6-million.

Resolve, a 4YO entire son of **MUSCLE HILL**, completed a feature double for his sire in capturing the \$400,000 TVG Free-for-all in 1:51.8.

Leading for the final three quarters, **Resolve** put his rivals to the sword with a last panel in 26.8 to score by three lengths.

Resolve boasts career earnings of \$915,125, of which he has bankrolled \$700,938 this year, placing in fifth position on the All Aged list.

MUSCLE HILL is ranked fourth on this year's overall stake money list with progeny earnings of \$7.4-million from just three racing crops.
