Muscle Hill doubles up in New Jersey Sire Stakes Championships

MUSCLE HILL's progeny dominated the \$100,000 New Jersey Sire Stakes Championships for three-year-old trotters at The Meadowlands last Saturday night (May 30).

World champion **Mission Brief** made it two for two this year and lifted her stakes tally to more than \$650,000 when she captured the \$100,000 Fillies' final.

Starting a 5-1 on favourite, the filly surged to the front at the half way point and, despite being headed momentarily in the straight, fought back to win by a length in 1:54.6.

Riley's Dream (by **MUSCLE HILL**) finished third.

Canepa Hanover completed the double for **MUSCLE HILL** when he captured the \$100,000 Final for three-year-old trotting colts in a season's record and a new lifetime mark of 1:51.2.

A \$475,000 yearling, **Canepa Hanover** led from the outset carving out the opening half in a dazzling 54.8 seconds to dominate his rivals.

Another **MUSCLE HILL** colt **Aldebaran Eagle** ran third.

Driver Yannick Gingras was very impressed with the colt.

"He got a little playful in the stretch, so I popped the plugs just to give him a reminder and he found another gear."

Canepa Hanover and **Mission Brief** are both being aimed at the \$1-million Hambletonian in August.

Closer to home, **MUSCLE HILL's** three-year-old daughter **Glenferrie Burn** posted her fourth win and took her stake earnings over the \$50,000 mark when she captured the Trotters Oaks Trial at Maryborough last Thursday (May 28).

Wishing Stone

The rich New York State Breeders Classic Finals for three-year-olds at Vernon Downs saw great results for two of the Stallions Australasia frozen semen stallions. These Finals had stakes of \$248,275 for the fillies and \$255,325 for the colts.

WISHING STONE's sire **Conway Hall** sired the Fillies winner **Barn Doll** which won in 1:52.2, and the second placegetter in the Final for the colts Habitat.

Conway Hall is currently North America's leading sire of three-year-old trotters in 2015.

WISHING STONE Tr3, 1:51.4 (\$2,244,320) is **Conway Hall's** richest and fastest progeny and stands his first full breeding season in 2015 after mixing racing and stallion duties last year.

LUCKY CHUCKY's stakes winning daughter **Lock Down Lindy**, a 1:55 two-year-old in 2014, finished second in the Fillies final.

LUCKY CHUCKY's first crop are now three-year-olds and have won over \$1,000,000 to date
