Southwind Frank filly grabs rich Stakes race

Flawless Country, a two-year-old filly and one of the first crop of former USA and Canadian 2YO Trotter of the Year **SOUTHWIND FRANK**, notched her second major Stakes success when she won the \$253,000 final of the Pennsylvania Sire Stakes Championship at Pocono Downs on Saturday (September 5).

After enjoying a pocket trip, the filly kicked into top gear in the home straight to win in 1:54.6.

It was her fourth straight win and her season's earnings of \$263,496 is the benchmark for her age, sex and gait.

A \$100,000 yearling, **Flawless Country** is out of a Donato Hanover mare.

The win vaulted **SOUTHWIND FRANK** into second position on the USA first season sires' list from a crop of only 49 foals.

Trixton produces Stakes winners

Emerging young sire **TRIXTON** produced two important Stakes winners in North America on Friday (September 11) and has jumped to fifth position on the 3YO Sires' Premiership.

Jula Trix Treasure, a three-year-old colt, came from midfield to win the \$167,000 Simcoe Stake in 1:53.8 at Woodbine Mohawk Park, Canada. It was his third win for the year and increased his bankroll to \$160,827.

Threfiftytwo (by ROYALTY FOR LIFE) was a close second.

The **TRIXTON** three-year-old filly **Common Sense S** was an effortless winner of the \$45,000 Garden State Trot in 1:55.4 at Freehold Raceway, New York.

Cuatro De Julio, a two-year-old colt by **TRIXTON**, became the fastest two-year-old trotter in North America this year when he captured a \$40,000 division of the Kentucky Sire Stakes at The Red Mile in 1:51.8. The colt has won eight of his 10 starts so far.

TRIXTON's progeny has earned almost \$1.7 million to date this year.

Brilliant **ROYALTY FOR LIFE** three-year-old filly **Warrawee Vicky** took out a \$88,895 division of the Simcoe Stake at Woodbine Mohawk Park in a new lifetime mark of 1:54. She has won three of her six starts in 2020 for \$111,776 in stakes.

Canadian classic double for Muscle Hill

The result of the \$560,000 Canadian Trotting Classic and the \$350,000 Eleganimage, the two plums for three-year-old trotters, held at Woodbine Mohawk Park on Saturday night (September 19), proved a triumph for Stallions Australasia sires.

Chestnut Hill, a colt by **MUSCLE HILL**, took out the Canadian Trotting Classic in 1:53.4, defeating a pair of colts by **TRIXTON** in **Play Trix On Me** (2nd) and **Jula Trix Treasure** (3rd).

Champion filly **Ramona Hill** waltzed away with the Eleganimage in a stakes record equalling 1:51.8, leading in a 1-3 result for **MUSCLE HILL** with **Sorella** third.

It was **Ramona Hill's** 12th success from 14 starts and lifted her stake tally to \$1,452,066.

MUSCLE HILL (\$3.3 million) has a stranglehold on this year's 3YO Sires' Premiership with **TRIXTON** (\$1.3 million) occupying fourth position.

Royalty For Life filly strikes Gold

You Will Be Queen, a two-year-old filly by **ROYALTY FOR LIFE**, scored the most important win of her career when she captured an \$80,864 division of the Ontario Sires Stakes Gold Series at Woodbine Mohawk Park on Monday (September 21).

After leading early then handing up, the filly powered down the home straight to win by 1-1/4 lengths in a career best 1:55.4.

You Will Be Queen now boasts a scoreline of three wins and four placings in seven starts for \$114,763. She is out of a mare by Deweycheatumnhowe (by Muscles Yankee).

Her triumph vaulted **ROYALTY FOR LIFE** into third position on the Ontario Sires Stakes sire premiership for 2020 with \$774,590.

Wishing Stone 2YO wins in 2:00

The **WISHING STONE** two-year-old **Keayang Ninja** became the second fastest male juvenile trotter in Australian history when he clocked 2:00 over 2150 metres at Bendigo on Wednesday (September 23).

The gelding covered his last 800 in 59.5.

It was his second win from three starts.

WISHING STONE sired a winning double on the third day of the Delaware County Fair with the two-year-old gelding **Malibu Kid**, who won a division of the Buckeye Stallion Series in 2:00.2, and the four-year-old **Lane Of Stone**, winner of the Ohio Breeders Championship Aged Trot in 1:53.4.

On the same card the **TRIXTON** three-year-old fillies **Caviart Eva** (1:54) and **Spoiled Princess** (1:55.4) captured both \$41,100 divisions of the Buckette.

To complete a huge week, the bonny **MUSCLE HILL** three-year-old filly **Sans Defaut** downed the colts in the \$83,800 Old Oaken Bucket in 1:55.
