Breeders Crown quinella

Champion sire **MUSCLE HILL** left the quinella pair, **Rules Dont Apply** and **Powderkeg**, in the Group 1 \$100,000 Final of the Vicbred Super Series for four-year-old entires and geldings at Melton on New Year's Eve.

Rules Dont Apply sat parked for most of the trip and was untroubled to fend off the late bid of **Powderkeg**. The gelding rated 1:57.1 over 2240 metres.

Out of a mare by Continentalman, **Rules Dont Apply** has now won eight races and \$105,940 in stakes.

MUSCLE HILL was also represented by the Breeders Crown Final placegetters **Aldebaran Zeus** (2nd) and **Bullion Harry** (3rd) in the three-year-old colts and geldings' division, and **Courage Stride** (2YO colt), **Queen Invasion** (3YO filly) and **Illawong Stardust** (4YO mare), who finished runner-up in their \$100,000 Finals.

Aldebaran Vera, a two-year-old filly by **TRIXTON**, ran a close second in the Group 1 two-year-old trotting fillies' Final.

On the same night, the brilliant **MUSCLE HILL** four-year-old **Bolt For Brilliance** overcame a 30 metre handicap to annex the Group 3 Greenlane Cup at Alexandra Park, Auckland.

Lucky Chucky winner at Albion Park

Kapai, a New Zealand bred son of **LUCKY CHUCKY**, the former USA 2YO and 3YO Trotter of the Year, is proving a splendid advertisement for his sire in Queensland.

The six-year-old came off a 40 metre handicap to easily account for his rivals at Albion Park on Friday (January 28), his second win at the Brisbane headquarters' track for the month.

Kapai has now won six races and \$53,028 in stakes.

Critical Advantage, a winner at Menangle in 1:58.7, was another recent winner sired by **LUCKY CHUCKY**.

From 25 Australian bred foals, **LUCKY CHUCKY** has left 11 winners from 15 starters at an average of \$24,392 per starter.
