Royalty For Life strikes Gold

The barnstorming finishing effort of two-year-old **ROYALTY FOR LIFE** colt **Threfiftytwo** in the \$108,000 Ontario Sires Stakes Gold Series division at Woodbine Mohawk Park on Thursday (July 4) provided the highlight of a busy weekend for Stallions Australasia sires.

Having his first start in Ontario, **Threfiftytwo** began quickly from the No. 8 gate to lead at the end of the opening quarter. After handing up, the colt ended up three deep on the marker pegs before gaining racing room at the three-quarters.

Threfiftytwo stopped the teletimer in 1:56.6 with the last two panels in 27 and 27.1.

He is out of a mare by CR Excalibur (by Yankee Glide).

On the same night the **WISHING STONE** two-year-old colt **Wading Boots** took out a \$40,000 division of the Ohio Sires Stakes in 1:57.8 at Scioto Downs. He is from a mare by SJ's Caviar.

Closer to home, **MUSCLE HILL's** two-year-old son **Powderkeg** made a clean sweep of the Vicbred Super Series outfinishing his opposition in the Group 1 \$100,000 Final at Melton.

Powderkeg is the second foal and winner out of the 10-win mare Sparks Ignite TT1:56.5 (by CR Commando).

The colt was bred and is raced by Adelaide enthusiast Geoff Easom.

Trixton trifectas New Jersey Sires Stakes

TRIXTON, the leading money-winning two-year-old sire in America this year, produced the trifecta in both finals of the New Jersey Sire Stakes for two-year-old trotters at The Meadowlands on Friday (July 12).

Fortune Starlet, the leading two-year-old trotter, captured the \$200,000 final for fillies in 1:54.6, while **Play Trix On Me** led home a **TRIXTON** trifecta in the \$160,000 final for colts and geldings in 1:55.6.

On the same card **MUSCLE HILL** sired both winners of the two-year-old fillies' leg of the Kindergarten Classic in **Ramona Hill** 1:54 (out of a **LUCKY CHUCKY** mare) and **Hello Tomorrow** 1:56.6.

TRIXTON's three-year-old daughter **Evident Beauty** equalled her lifetime mark of 1:52.6, leading for the last three quarters in a \$124,000 division of the Del Miller Memorial at The Meadowlands on Saturday night (July 13).

Evident Beauty, who has won four of her five starts this season and \$188,633, is the leading stakes-earning three-year-old filly in America.

Royalty in Canada!

The Stallions Australasia sire roster was represented by important winners in three different countries last week.

ROYALTY FOR LIFE's bonny two-year-old filly **Warrawee Vicky** made it four wins from four starts when she led for the last three fractions to easily win a \$72,666 division of the Ontario Sires Stakes Gold at Grand River Raceway last Wednesday (July 24).

She has won her four attempts so far by a combined 13-1/2 lengths.

WISHING STONE was credited with his third two-year-old winner from only six foals when the filly **Venkman** saluted for the first time following three placings at Maryborough on Thursday (July 25).

WISHING STONE has left four winners from eight Australian born foals

Meanwhile, in America, **MUSCLE HILL** left two three-year-old winners at the big Meadowlands meeting on Saturday (July 27) in **Don't Let 'Em**, who won the \$81,200 W. N. Reynolds Memorial in a career-best 1:50.4, and **When Dovescry**, who captured a \$50,000 Hambletonian Oaks elimination in 1:51.6.
