Trixton fillies on fire

The \$124,000 Hudson Filly Trot, run at Yonkers Raceway, New York on Saturday night (August 31), was a triumph for promising sire **TRIXTON** as the sire of the winner **Golden Tricks** and the third placegetter **Starita**.

Golden Tricks, who enjoyed a saloon passage, prevailed in a tight finish in 1:56.

She has won six races and \$177,940 in stakes.

TRIXTON has left the winners of more than \$2-million already this season.

Royalty For Life sires fast filly

The Hambletonian winner and USA 3YO Trotting Colt of the Year **ROYALTY FOR LIFE**, whose first crop achieved outstanding success in Canada, has left a smart three-year-old filly in **Royal Esteem**.

Out of a Kadabra mare, **Royal Esteem** won by eight lengths in a career-best 1:54.6 at Woodbine Mohawk Park last Thursday (September 7) and pushed her stake earnings over the \$100,000 mark.

ROYALTY FOR LIFE is in second position on this year's Ontario Sires Stakes two-year-old staking and fourth on the All Aged list.

MUSCLE HILL was represented by important winners in four different countries last weekend.

Green Manalishi S, a three-year-old colt, and **When Dovescry**, a three-year-old filly, both won divisions of the Simcoe Stakes in 1:53 and 1:54.8 at Woodbine Mohawk Park, while **Cloud Nine Fashion**, a three-year-old filly, took out the \$50,000 Pennsylvania Sire Stake Consolation in 1:53.4 at The Meadows.

The American-bred **Propulsion**, Europe's first sub 1:50 trotter, won at rich European Trotting Masters Final at Vincennes, Paris, rating 1:55,4 for 1 11/16 miles.

On the homefront, the USA **MUSCLE HILL** mare **Lily Stride** advanced her earnings to \$720,000 with an impressive win at Menangle on Saturday night (September 7).

ROYALTY FOR LIFE and **MUSCLE HILL** are both members of the Stallions Australasia sire roster.

Feature treble for Stallions Australasia in The Stallions Australasia sires **MUSCLE HILL, TRIXTON** and **ROYALTY FOR LIFE** made a clean sweep of the three trotting features at Woodbine Mohawk Park, Canada on Saturday night (September 14).

The **MUSCLE HILL** three-year-old colt **Green Manalishi S** captured the \$C605,000 Canadian Trotting Classic, **TRIXTON's** three-year-old daughter **Evident Beauty** captured the \$C376,000 Eleganimage in 1:53, while the **ROYALTY FOR LIFE** two-year-old gelding **HP Royal Theo** outmuscled his rivals in the \$C370,000 William Wellwood Memorial in a career-best 1:54.4.

Green Manalishi S led from the outset and maintained a solid tempo to win by half a length in 1:52.8. It was his 10th success and pushed his stake earnings over the \$1 million plateau.

Evident Beauty overcame a post position 10, settled midfield on the outer and powered home to score a half-length victory. The **TRIXTON** fillies **When Dovescry** and **Princess Deo** finished third and fourth respectively. **Evident Beauty** has won nine races and \$666,898.

While **HP Royal Theo**, having only his sixth start, was midfield early before moving forward into the one-out in the second stanza. Angled three deep on the home turn, **HP Royal Theo** unleashed a 28.4 final quarter to score by 1-3/4 lengths.

Trixton fillies in the Money!

Stallions A pair of talented **TRIXTON** fillies, **Evident Beauty** and **Tricky Sister**, won important races in North America last Friday (September 20).

Evident Beauty, a three-year-old, maintained her devastating form by winning the \$135,000 Moni Maker in 1:53.6 at Hoosier Park, Indiana, advancing her lifetime stakes tally to \$US735,398.

The lightly raced two-year-old **Tricky Sister** notched her maiden success in the \$70,000 New Jersey Sires Stakes Final at Freehold Raceway, taking full advantage of a pocket trip to win by 4-1/4 lengths in 1:59.6.

TRIXTON's three-year-olds have already earned \$1.75-million this year, while his two-year-olds have banked in excess of \$900,000.

Meanwhile, **WISHING STONE** made it five winners from five starters when the four-year-old gelding **Zarem**, who was bred by Paul Graydon, won twice in Victoria in the space of four days.

Gold trifecta for Royalty For Life

The Hambletonian winner **ROYALTY FOR LIFE**, one of the impressive Stallions Australasia sire roster, produced the trifecta in the \$104,800 Ontario Sires Stakes Gold leg for two-year-old colts and geldings at Grand River Raceway, Canada on Monday (September 23).

Threefiftytwo, a colt, led throughout in 1:59.4 to defeat **Your Still Up** and **Tuckers Out**.

Another **ROYALTY FOR LIFE** two-year-old colt **Babidibou** ran third in a \$105,600 OSS Gold leg on the same card.

ROYALTY FOR LIFE is in third position on the OSS Sires premiership for two-year-olds and fourth on the All Aged list.

Muscle Hill mare sets new world mark

Brilliant **MUSCLE HILL** four-year-old mare **Manchego** established a new world record for trotting mares on a five-eighths mile track of 1:50.2 when she trounced older male rivals in the \$171,250 Dayton Trotting Derby at Hollywood Dayton Raceway, Ohio on Friday (September 27) night.

Having her first outing for three weeks and starting from the wide No. 6 gate, the mare sped straight to the top and carved out fractions of 26.6, 27.4, 28.2 and 27.9 in her historic mile.

The \$1.7 million earner won by an ever increasing nine lengths.

In the Bluegrass Stakes at The Red Mile, Lexington on the same day, **Ramona Hill** (by **MUSCLE HILL**) and **Common Sense S** (by **TRIXTON**) both won \$82,000 divisions.

Ramona Hill took full advantage of a pocket trip to score in 1:52.8 and is unbeaten in four attempts, while the Swedish bred **Common Sense S** enjoyed a soft passage to win in 1:53.6 and make it five from nine.
