Trixton and Odds On Amethyst, a pair of well credentialed three-year-olds by Muscle Hill, won their qualifying trials in impressive fashion at The Meadowlands on April 26.

Odds On Amethyst, the Bluegrass Stakes winner, took a new lifetime mark of 1:54.2 leading from the outset, while Trixton, the highest priced trotting yearling of 2012 at \$360,000, won in 1:57.4 including a 27.8 seconds final quarter.

Muscle Hill, a \$3.2-million winning son of Muscles Yankee, was America's leading first-season trotting sire in 2013, finished third on the overall list and was the leading sire of 1:55 two-year-olds.

Wishing Stone, who is standing his first season in New Jersey, has met with a strong demand from European breeders on the strength of his racetrack deeds there in 2011 and 2012.

There has been 240 doses of Wishing Stone's semen sold to Italy, France and Sweden already this year with many more clients on the waiting list.
